Dear Folks,

I shudder everytime I look at this paper & still have not brought myself to hear writing on the pink or orange sheets. The white is excellent. The blue (this) is for people in getting the letter without regard to the color.

This evening I went with Spence & the movies, but one hour before the picture started they had a traffic line so we decided to go. Errol was playing in "Summa something" but by the time it was more like "My York & Frankie playing."

This evening I found a stack of books which aroused my interest. I looked at books in every language. Quite a number of the books interested me very much only to find the next book more interesting. After looking at them for about an hour I gave up. Had I could easily spend a day looking at those books.

Enclosed you find a few more pictures. The two large ones are of Versailles front & back views. One of Turenburg City, Germany in Paris when we were there together, & one of myself taken about a month ago.

Received today three letters from you & answered some questions. Yes buy the camera if you get it & keep it yourself. What happened to the first camera is a long story. Letter forgotten & as to my location in the picture I put out from a newspaper Grandmother's picture in the right section although I don't know if she got into the right person.

This evening I expect to write at least one letter in French as I close now.
