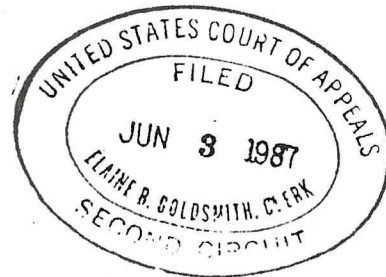

Order of Disbarment

An order having been entered on February 23, 1987, in the Appellate Division, Supreme Court of the State of New York Second Judicial Department striking from the roll of attorneys and counselors-at-law of the State of New York the name of George Sassower, who was admitted to practice as an attorney before this court on November 1, 1960,

And a certified copy of said order having been filed in this court,

And an order having been entered on March 12, 1987, pursuant to Rule 46(f)(1) of the rules of this court supplementing the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure, disbarring George Sassower from the practice of law before this court upon such terms and conditions as set forth in the above-mentioned February 23, 1987 order of the Second Judicial Department,

And a stay of this Court's disbarment order having been granted upon receipt of a timely motion for modification or revocation of that order, pursuant to Rule 46(f)2,

And the motion having been denied by order of a panel of this court filed June 3, 1987,

IT IS ORDERED, that the stay of the order of disbarment is hereby vacated and the order of March 12, 1987 is hereby reissued, until further order of this court.
