I understand your concern about the misuse of the nominating power by this Administration. You identify issues which have been a matter of contention and debate for many years, over the course of a number of Administrations. Although a number of Members of the Senate have sought to de-politicize the recommendations process through the use of non-partisan expert selection panels in their states, the final nominating decision remains with the President, so you should address your complaints directly to him.
