RE: Nomination of Andrew O'Rourke

Dear Mr. Willis:

We are informed that you have succeeded Ronald Olson, who stepped down in August as Chairman of the ABA Standing Committee on Federal Judiciary.

By letter, dated June 18, 1992, Mr. Olson stated to us that he had received from then ABA President D'Alemberte a copy of our critique of the qualifications of Andrew O'Rourke--which we had sent to President D'Alemberte under a coverletter, dated May 19, 1992.

On June 26, 1992, we responded to Mr. Olson's June 18th letter. Since the very reason why the ABA rates prospective nominees in the first place is to protect the public from unfit judicial candidates, we called upon the Standing Committee on Federal Judiciary, <u>inter alia</u>, to retract its favorable rating of Mr. O'Rourke in light of our <u>documented</u> showing of his absolute unfitness.

Since that date, we have not been favored with a response from either Mr. Olson or anyone on behalf of the ABA.

Please advise us promptly: (a) whether the members of the Standing Committee on Federal Judiciary have reviewed our critique; and (b) whether they plan to retract their endorsement of Mr. O'Rourke based thereon.
