RE: Nomination of Andrew O'Rourke

Dear President Bush:

More than six weeks ago, a copy of our November 20, 1991 letter to Chairman Joseph Biden of the Senate Judiciary Committee was sent to you relative to your nomination of Andrew O'Rourke for a federal judgeship. To date, we have heard nothing from anyone on your staff--not even an acknowledgment of receipt.

We herewith enclose a second copy of that letter. Please note the penultimate paragraph appearing on page three:

"This [November 20, 1991] letter is also being sent to the White House with a similar request as to the qualifications and background which were reviewed by the President when he endorsed Senator D'Amato's recommendation of Mr. O'Rourke's name." (emphasis added)
