Introduced by M. of A. LANCMAN -- read once and referred to the Committee on Judiciary -- committee discharged, bill amended, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee

AN ACT to amend the judiciary law, in relation to directing the commission on judicial nominations to forward to the governor all well qualified candidates for associate judge and/or chief judge

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 63 of the judiciary law, as 2 amended by chapter 35 of the laws of 1983, is amended to read as follows:
- 2. [(a) In recognition of the unique responsibilities of the chief 5 judge of the court of appeals for policies of judicial administration, for a vacancy in the office of chief judge the commission shall recommend to the governor seven persons.
- (b) For a vacancy in the office of associate judge, the commission shall recommend to the governor at least three persons and not more than seven persons. Should more than one vacancy exist at the same time in the office of associate judge, the number of persons recommended by the 12 commission to the governor shall be at least three plus one additional 13 person for each vacancy in such office, and not more than seven plus one additional person for each vacancy in such office.
- 14 (c) Should vacancies exist in the offices of chief judge and associate 16 judge at the same time, the commission shall recommend for the office of 17 associate judge the number of persons as provided in paragraph (b) of
- 18 this subdivision, provided, however, that in addition thereto the
- commission may also recommend for associate judge any of the persons who
- 20 have been recommended to the governor for the office of chief judge.]
- 21 FOR A VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF CHIEF JUDGE OR ASSOCIATE JUDGE, THE
- 22 COMMISSION SHALL RECOMMEND TO THE GOVERNOR ALL WELL QUALIFIED PERSONS 23 WHO EXEMPLIFY THE CRITERIA SET FORTH IN SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION.

24 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
