The New York Times is the subject of an unprecedented public interest lawsuit, suing it for "journalistic fraud" and seeking to remove its front-page motto, "All the News That's Fit to Print".

The lawsuit is brought by the non-partisan, non-profit citizens' organization, Center for Judicial Accountability, Inc. (CJA) and is politically-explosive in that it chronicles The Times' election-rigging for Senator Hillary Clinton and New York Attorney General Spitzer, among others.
