<u>FOIL/RECORDS REQUEST</u>: Certificates of approval issued by the Director of the Budget, filed with the Comptroller, Senate Finance Committee Chair, & Assembly Ways and Means Committee Chair for:

- (1) State Operations Budget Bill #S.2000-D/A.3000-D;
- (2) Aid to Localities Budget Bill #S.2003-D/A.3003-D;
- (3) Capital Projects Budget Bill #S.2004-D/A.3004-D.

Governor Cuomo's original fiscal year 2017-2018 budget bills for State Operations (#S.2000/A.3000); for Aid to Localities (#S.2003/A.3003); and for Capital Projects (#S.2004/A.3004), each contained the identical §1(d):

"No moneys appropriated by this chapter shall be available for payment until a certificate of approval has been issued by the director of the budget, who shall file such certificate with the department of audit and control, the chairperson of the senate finance committee and the chairperson of the assembly ways and committee."

This §1(d) was retained in all the "amendings" of these bills, culminating in enacted State Operations Budget Bill #S.2000-D/A.3000-D; enacted Aid to Localities Budget Bill #S.2003-D/A.3003-D; and enacted Capital Projects Budget Bill #S.2004-D/A.3004-D.

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Law (F.O.I.L.) [Public Officers Law, Article VI], request is made for the director of the budget's "certificate of approval", filed with "the department of audit and control, the chairperson of the senate finance committee and the chairperson of the assembly ways and means committee", for each of these three bills.
