(Chapter 59, Part XXX, of the Laws of 2019)


Pursuant to Public Officers Law Articles VI and VII [FOIL & Open Meetings Law], Senate Rule XIV [“Freedom of Information”], and Assembly Rule VIII [“Public Access to Records”], this is to request the following pertaining to the Public Campaign Financing and Election Commission, established by Part XXX of Revenue Budget Bill #S.1509-C/A.2009-C:

- (1) records reflecting when, if as yet, the Commission established a website – and what that website is;
- (2) records reflecting when, if as yet, the Commission announced its contact information, *to wit*, a phone number, e-mail address, and mailing address – and what they are;
- (3) records reflecting when, if as yet, the Commission established a physical office address – and where it is;
- (4) records reflecting when, if as yet, the Commission secured/hired staff – and how many and whether they are employed full-time in the operations of the Commission;
- (5) records reflecting when, if as yet, the Commission secured a budget to pay staff and expenses – and what that budget is;
- (6) records reflecting when and in what fashion the Commission announced its first meeting – and to whom the announcement was disseminated;

- (7) the video of the Commission's first public meeting, on August 21, 2019 – and any transcription thereof;
- (8) minutes/transcriptions of any prior and subsequent Commission meetings, including meetings held in executive session;
- (9) records reflecting when and in what fashion the Commission announced the dates and locations of its public hearings;
- (10) records reflecting when, if at all, the Commission announced registration procedures for testifying at its public hearings – and what they are.

Pursuant to Public Officers Law §89.3, your response is required “within five business days” of receipt of this request. I would appreciate if you e-mailed it to me at elena@judgewatch.org.
