As you know, Senate Rule VII, §5(d) states:

“Each standing committee is required to file with the Secretary of the Senate an annual report, detailing its legislative and oversight activities. Such report shall be posted to the Senate web site.” (underlining added).

Currently, it does not appear that any 2019 annual reports are posted for last year’s 38 Senate standing committees – at least not *via* the Senate’s “OPEN DATA” feature: [https://www.nysenate.gov/open-data?field\\_date\\_value2%5Bvalue%5D%5Byear%5D=&title=Annual+Report](https://www.nysenate.gov/open-data?field_date_value2%5Bvalue%5D%5Byear%5D=&title=Annual+Report).

- (7) Corporations, Authorities and Commissions;
- (8) Finance;
- (9) Budget and Revenues;
- (10) Rules;
- (11) Ethics and Internal Governance.
