

May 29, 2020 FOIL request – Senate Bill #S.3302 (2019-2020):

On February 5, 2019, Senator Patrick Gallivan introduced, into the Senate Bill/Concurrent Resolution #S.3302, “proposing amendments to article 7 of the constitution, in relation to items of appropriation”.

According to the Senate’s webpage for the bill: <https://www.nysenate.gov/legislation/bills/2019/s3302>, it was referred to the Senate Judiciary Committee, which, on February 7, 2019, requested an opinion from the Attorney General. That opinion was referred to the Judiciary Committee on March 1, 2019. This year, on January 8, 2020, the same bill was referred to the Judiciary Committee, which, on February 14, 2020, again sought an opinion from the Attorney General. On March 13, 2020, the opinion was referred to the Judiciary Committee.

Pursuant to FOIL, this is to request: (1) a copy of the Senate’s two requests to the Attorney General for an advisory opinion, including the transmitting letters/e-mails; and (2) the Attorney General’s two advisory opinions – and any subsequent correspondence thereon.
