On February 12, 2024, we received your FOIL request.

Enclosed please find records responsive to your request. Please be advised that Public Officers Law (POL) §88 enumerates those records that are required to be made available by the state legislature pursuant to FOIL. In addition to POL §88, the Assembly has adopted a policy that the central administrative records of the Assembly are governed by a similar presumption of disclosure as governs access to executive agency records. This policy has been adopted as Rule VIII of the Assembly Rules. However, since the records you seek would not be central administrative records, this rule is not applicable to your request.

The New York State Assembly does not have any records that would be responsive to the remainder of your request.

Based on the foregoing the remainder of your request is denied. Enclosed for your review is a copy of "A Guide to the Public Inspection and Copying of Legislative Records," along with a copy of POL §88 and Rule VIII of the Assembly Rules.
