[Article VII, §1 of the New York State Constitution](#) empowers the Governor to make “recommendations” to the Legislature pertaining to the Legislative and Judiciary budgets.

The website of the Governor’s Division of the Budget, <https://www.budget.ny.gov/>, posts the Governor’s combined [Legislative/Judiciary Budget Bill #S.3001/A.3001, dated January 21, 2025](#), that she submitted to the Legislature, but seemingly no “recommendations” by her pertaining thereto.
