We have received your complaint and determined that no action is warranted by the Committee at this time.

Specifically, as you know, the Committee determined to dismiss your original complaint pertaining to Attorney General Letitia A. James and Solicitor General Barbara Underwood, and your subsequent request for reconsideration was reviewed and denied. This ended the Committee's review of your complaint in accordance with the Committee's Rules. You then wrote to the Court regarding the said dismissal and denial of reconsideration, and the Court found no irregularities with respect to the said decisions of the Committee.

Your current filing, in which you, *inter alia*, urge that Chairs of the Committee and others should be "prosecuted for corruption" for the dismissal of your complaint is plainly without merit and therefore warrants no further consideration. We are therefore closing the above-referenced dockets.
