
Dear Ms. Sassower:

As you are aware, we deferred your complaints against attorneys Letitia James (Docket No. 2024.2916), and Barbara Underwood (Docket No. 2024.3047) because there was pending litigation regarding similar issues. We recently received your email correspondence dated April 29, 2025, advising us that the litigation has now concluded with the issuance of the Court of Appeals decision and order dated March 18, 2025, in which your appeal was dismissed and denied.

Specifically, your allegations against Solicitor General Barbara Underwood and Attorney General Letitia James have been conclusively litigated in court and there has been no finding of wrongdoing by the attorneys. Therefore, we have concluded that no further investigation or action is warranted. We note that you have filed a motion for reargument of the March 18, 2025 Court of Appeals order.

You may seek review of this decision by submitting a written request for reconsideration to this office addressed to “Committee Chair” at the above **email** address within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter.
