## New York State Commission on Ethics and Lobbying in Government to Hold Public Hearing

The New York State Commission on Ethics and Lobbying in Government will hold a [public hearing](#) at 10 a.m. on Wednesday, March 29. To fulfill the requirement of Executive Law Section 94(4)(i), the Commission will receive testimony and public comment on COELIG's operations; potential or proposed changes to the laws under COELIG's jurisdiction; the consistency and effectiveness of the Commission's and its predecessors' rules, regulations, and advisory opinions; and recommendations to improve the structure, administration, communication, and enforcement of ethics and lobbying laws and regulations in New York State.
