Thank you for your powerful testimony at the <u>November 1, 2023 hearing of the Senate Judiciary</u> <u>Committee and Senate Committee on Children and Families</u> about a "failed and unethical system" that is "broken everywhere".

Ms. Kassenoff's final Facebook message provided me with your e-mail address. She wrote:

"My primary contact is Wayne Baker (<u>federallitigator@gmail.com</u>), should you have anything to share with him and who has all my documents from the divorce case etc... Please don't let my demise be in vain. Reach out to him to organize yourselves, use the facts of my case (which Wayne also has access to), and make change."

I am the director and co-founder of the non-partisan, non-profit citizens' organization <u>Center for Judicial</u> <u>Accountability, Inc. (CJA)</u> – based in White Plains, New York -- which, for decades, has sought to change the corruption that infests the judiciary and the collusion and cover-up of those charged with oversight. This includes senators before whom you testified on November 1st – and it is, presumably, for this reason that I was NOT permitted to testify at the hearing. This is recounted, with substantiating proof, by my above written testimony, stating, in pertinent part:

"...ANY examination of the EVIDENCE of what has gone on over these many, many years – and it is made easy by CJA's successive lawsuits, suing the Legislature for its corruption – each 'thrown' by fraudulent judicial decisions^{fn} – would reveal that the murder of Kyra Franchetti, about which her mother testified, and the suicide of Catherine Kassenoff, to which the executor of her estate testified, could have reasonably been prevented. It required nothing more than for the senators – and their assembly counterparts – to have long ago discharged their oversight responsibilities, as was their duty." (capitalization in the original).

Above-attached & here linked is my "Corruption Complaint against Judges, Government-Attorneys, & Government-Retained Attorneys Arising from a Fraudulent, Culturally-Biased Child Abuse/Neglect Petition against Innocent Parents". Its "Conclusion" (at p. 29) reads:

"The foregoing long-overdue complaint is being furnished, additionally, to the Commission on Legislative, Judicial and Executive Compensation, before which I testified on October 13, 2023, handing up a copy of the Independent Expert Report [link removed], in substantiation of my testimony as to the corruption infesting the judiciary – a threshold, 'appropriate factor' of constitutional dimension that it is statutorily-required to 'take into account'. My words were as follows (VIDEO, at 2hrs/45mins):

'Lastly, I don't want you to believe that the corruption infesting the judiciary is only in cases of magnitude such as the cases that I have here presented. I have a, a independent report that I wrote about a Family Court case out of Monroe County, a mother called me in distress because her child had been taken away from her. And she begged me to assist her. Without charge, I, I examined the record -- and I wrote a report that goes on, and you should know this is only the first piece of it. But the corruption involving this report at the Family Court level, at the Appellate Division Fourth Department from which you come, Chair Fahey, you need to take testimony. You have subpoena power. You need to – you need to examine the corruption in the judiciary –'

The only correction I would make is to add a reference to the corresponding corruption in the Monroe County Supreme Court pertaining to the Independent Expert Report.

As the Commission on Legislative, Judicial and Executive Compensation's enabling statute requires you to assist the Commission, upon its request, ^{fn3} perhaps that is the most expeditious way for it to proceed – requesting that you furnish it with the results of the investigation that is your <u>duty</u> to make with respect to this fully-documented, facially-meritorious complaint."

I am available to assist you, to the max, in investigating this complaint – and would welcome giving testimony under oath. I know the innocent parents feel likewise.
