As you know, the December 10, 2018 Report of the Committee on Legislative and Executive Compensation preserved your stipends in recognition of the “significantly more work” and “additional duties” you are expected to perform (at p. 19). That Report is a fraud on the People of the State of New York and larceny of their tax dollars – and the particulars are set forth by the above-attached analysis of the Report.

Below is the e-mail I sent yesterday to Temporary Senate President Stewart-Cousins and Assembly Speaker Heastie, with the analysis and its accompanying letter-NOTICE. It is now sent to you so that you can demonstrate how you discharge the greater responsibilities for which you are paid. Presumably, this includes alerting the other 57 Senate members and 141 Assembly members to matters of seriousness and substance involving them. In any event, I request that you promptly forward this e-mail to them, with its above-attached July 15, 2019 letter-NOTICE and analysis and below e-mail, each addressed to ALL 63 Senate and 150 Assembly Members.

Hard copies of the letter-NOTICE and analysis, with exhibits, are being priority mailed today to Temporary Senate President Stewart-Cousins and Assembly Speaker Heastie – and I trust they will make

same available to you and all other Senate and Assembly Members, upon request. RE: NOTICE of Your Duty to Void the December 10, 2018 Report of the Committee on Legislative & Executive Compensation that Boosted Your Salaries

This is to give you NOTICE of what you should already know: that the December 10, 2018 Report of the Committee on Legislative & Executive Compensation that boosted your salaries is a fraud upon the People of the State of New York – and a larceny of their tax dollars.

To assist you in belatedly discharging your responsibilities to protect the People you were elected to serve, attached is the Center for Judicial Accountability's formal NOTICE to you, transmitting an analysis of the December 10, 2018 Report. Four hard copies, with the exhibits to the analysis, will be sent, priority-mail:

- (1) to the Governor, for himself and the Lieutenant Governor;
- (2) to the Attorney General;
- (3) to the Temporary Senate President, for herself & the other 62 Senate Members; and

(4) to the Assembly Speaker, for himself & the other 149 Assembly Members.

For your further convenience, CJA's website, www.judgewatch.org, posts the NOTICE, analysis, exhibits, and other referred-to substantiating evidence, accessible *via* the prominent center link, now renamed: "2018 Report of the Committee on Legislative & Executive Compensation – Unconstitutionality & Fraud in Plain Sight". Please confirm, as soon as possible – and no later than August 15, 2019 – that you will be taking steps to void the Report, to return the already-disbursed salary increases, and to criminally prosecute the Compensation Committee members and their *pro bono* counsel for their penal law violations including: Penal Law §175.35: "offering a false instrument for filing in the first degree"; Penal Law §195.20: "defrauding the government"; Penal §190.65: "scheme to defraud in the first degree"; and Penal Law §496.05; §496.06: "PUBLIC TRUST ACT: "corrupting the government in the first degree"; "public corruption".
