Are President Biden's nominees for U.S. Attorney being vetted for conflicts of interest by the White House & the Senate Judiciary Committee? The EVIDENCE is NOT encouraging -- and, indeed, exposes a succession of MAJOR scandals.

I am director and co-founder of the New York-based national, non-partisan, non-profit citizens' organization, Center for Judicial Accountability, Inc. (CJA) -- and wish to alert you to President Biden's politicization of the DOJ by his four U.S. Attorney nominations for New York -- presently before the Senate Judiciary Committee, which is COLLUDING with him. By this I mean not just the Democratic majority, but the Republican minority.

On March 23rd and April 27th, I sent the Biden White House written messages as to the necessity to carefully vet the prospective four U.S. Attorney nominees for New York for conflicts of interest, lest they politicize the U.S. Attorney offices by NOT prosecuting for public corruption New York's mostly Democratic highest constitutional officers -- the subjects of a FULLY-DOCUMENTED complaint that NY's four acting U.S. Attorneys are "sitting on". I received NO response, other than automated acknowledgments of receipt.

On July 26th, the Biden White House announced its first set of eight U.S. Attorney nominations -- among them for New York's western district. Hoping for "leadership" from Republican Senate Judiciary Committee Member Josh Hawley, I reached out to him, including by an August 4th letter, to which I received NO response. Thereafter, in the wake of the White House's August 10th announcement of a second set of eight U.S. Attorney nominations, three of which were for New York's other districts: southern, eastern, and northern, I reached out to other Republican Senate Judiciary Committee minority members -- and then to the Senate Judiciary Committee's Democratic majority office, to its Republican minority office and to Democratic minority members. My chain of e-mails reciting what has been happening, furnished them with my August 4th letter, and culminated in a September 3rd e-mail, to which I have received NO response.

In short, the Democratic Senate Judiciary Committee majority office does NOT answer its phones, return voice messages, or respond to requests for info and documents pertaining to President Biden's four U.S. Attorney nominees for New York. The Republican Senate Judiciary Committee minority office and members are only marginally better -- notwithstanding the HUGE opportunity that my August 4th letter furnished Republicans to raise essential questions about Biden White House vetting, to topple -- by the answers -- New York's mostly-Democratic highest constitutional officers in its three government branches, to demonstrate a modicum of fealty to former President Trump, and to prove, resoundingly, that New York has an agenda-driven/"fake news"/election-rigging press -- virtually all of it "left-leaning" and "progressive".
