The above-attached corrects typos, makes clarifying adjustments, and adds further EVIDENTIARY materials to my June 29th NON-PARTISAN STORY PROPOSAL.

The most significant addition is at pages 9-10 concerning the "disruption of Congress" cert petition that was before the Supreme Court in 2007 – furnishing essential contextual background to my delivery to the Court, just months later, of my March 6, 2008 letter to Chief Justice Roberts and the Critique of the Breyer Committee Report.

I do not believe that this addition should impact your ability to confirm by tomorrow that ProPublica will be pursuing "with no regards to partisanship" this phenomenal story about the justices and "ethics and the Supreme Court".

As I have an appointment in midtown Manhattan on Thursday, July 6th, at 2 pm, I propose a meeting at ProPublica's downtown Manhattan headquarters either before or after. Please let me know, and, if yes, I will bring the extra copy I have of the March 6, 2008 Critique and its Exhibit Compendium, so as to facilitate your investigative journalism.
