Dear Phil,

Thank you for your below e-mail. I have re-read [your April 25th column](#) – and you are INCORRECT as to your understanding about the state budget, on which the Yonkers budget is dependent, starting with your statement that “the state budget is now nearly a month overdue” and your inference that “negotiations” by “Legislative leaders – including Yonkers’ own Senate Majority Leader Andrea Stewart-Cousins” – holding up the budget over “a mix of policy disputes” are proper because “In New York, the budget is never just about money. It’s the only time each year when the Legislature has the leverage to force action on contentious policy issues...”.

I am well familiar with the definition of fraud – and fraud is NOT an “overstatement” or “intemperate” description of what has been going on. Have you read my above-attached April 14th grand jury/public corruption complaint to Westchester D.A. Cacace – with its substantiating hyperlinks, such as to my [written testimony for the Legislature’s February 11th budget hearing on “local government officials/general government” – the same budget hearing at which Yonkers Mayor Spano testified](#). That written testimony – as, likewise my below e-mail to you -- furnishes the EVIDENCE as to New York’s financially-constrained, ROLLING BUDGET ([Article VII, Section 4](#)). It also furnishes the EVIDENCE of the fraud by which non-fiscal, non-revenue policy is inserted into the budget *via* so-called “Article VII bills” – linking to my [January 23rd e-mail to the FOIL officers of the Governor, Division of the Budget, Senate, Assembly, & Legislative Bill Drafting Commission](#), attaching my [January 23rd FOIL request](#), and, additionally, [CJA’s 2026 FOIL webpage](#) on which the responses to that FOIL request are posted.

Kindly review these – and then let’s speak, so that you can begin reporting on how Yonkers state legislators, such as Stewart-Cousins & Gary Pretlow, each running for re-election, have been corrupting constitutional, lawful state governance, starting with the state budget and the Legislature’s own budget, for which they must be indicted and will be convicted, including for grand larceny of the public fisc.

It appears from your yesterday's column "[New York State's Budget is Late. Where Does that Leave Yonkers?](#)" that you are unaware that the state budget is "OFF THE CONSTITUTIONAL RAILS" and that New York has a rolling budget, with each appropriation bill, excepting for the legislature and judiciary, becoming "law immediately" upon the Senate and Assembly reconciling their separate strike-outs and reductions in those bills ([Article VII, Section 4](#)), and that the inclusion of non-revenue policy in the budget, by so-called "Article VII bills", is the product of fraud and is unconstitutional.

For more than a dozen years, this has been the subject of testimony, complaints, and lawsuits by the [Center for Judicial Accountability, Inc. \(CJA\)](#), a non-partisan, non-profit citizens' organization, based in White Plains, of which I am director and co-founder. Above-attached, pertaining to the FY2026-27 state budget, is CJA's April 14th grand jury/public corruption complaint to New York's 62 D.A.s., including Westchester D.A. Cacace, from whom prosecution is sought against Westchester's state legislators – most importantly, Temporary Senate President Andrea Stewart-Cousins and Assembly Ways and Means Committee Chair Gary Pretlow.

A week ago, I forwarded the complaint to [The Journal News](#) by the below April 19th e-mail, to which there has been no response – and I am cc'ing it on this e-mail, as a reminder.

I am available to answer questions and to assist you, to the max. Call me, *no matter how early or late*, as TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE, both with respect to the state budget and this year's elections.

I have received no responses from you to my [March 13th e-mail](#) entitled “TIME-SENSITIVE: The Corruption of the Legislative Budget & State Budget by Senator Stewart-Cousins & Westchester's Other State Legislators -- & the 2026 Elections”, including [Statehouse Reporter Emily Barnes](#), who, as I subsequently discovered from the “[exportable list](#)” on the [Legislative Correspondents Association’s new website](#), is an LCA member for the “USA Today Network”.

As an LCA member, with a listed e-mail address of ebarnes@usatodayco.com, I sent Ms. Barnes two further e-mails. The first, an [April 7th e-mail](#) entitled “ALL ten of the FY2026-27 budget bills are rife with unconstitutionality, fraud, & larceny – the EVIDENCE of which upends NYS' 2026 electoral races”, contained a paragraph reading:

“If it is not your intention to report on this EVIDENCE – and to get answers from the public officers responsible, starting with Temporary Senate President Stewart-Cousins, Assembly Speaker Heastie, Senate Finance Committee Chair Krueger, Assembly Ways and Means Committee Chair Pretlow, and, of course, Governor Hochul, each running for re-election, please forward this e-mail to your editors and highest managerial levels and counsel, so that they can be held accountable, with you, for your knowingly false,

corruption-abetting, election-rigging journalism, having NO First Amendment protection.”

Did Ms. Barnes share this April 7th e-mail with you? How about my below April 14th e-mail, with the above-attached NOTICE & grand jury/public corruption complaint to NYS’ 62 D.A.s, including Westchester County D.A. Cacace, containing a comparable paragraph to LCA reporters:

“If it is your intention to continue to conceal and affirmatively misrepresent the situation by your journalism, please, as previously requested, immediately forward this e-mail to the highest editors and managerial levels of your respective publications, including counsel, so that there is no question of their knowledge of, and liability for, your corruption-abetting, election-rigging, journalistic fraud, having no First Amendment protection.”

And did Ms. Barnes share these e-mails with other USA Today editors and management, such as listed on the staff directory of the Democrat & Chronicle, which is where she is listed. Among these, Publisher Heather Falkey, Executive Editor Michael Kilian, Deputy New York State Editor Sarah Taddeo, News Director Scott Norris, and Enterprise Editor William Ramsey, all herein cc’d. Did they approve Ms. Barnes’ corruption-concealing, cover-up journalism about the FY2026-27 state budget, directly impacting this year’s electoral races?

So that I may be guided accordingly, please confirm that the Journal News will be reporting on the EVIDENCE I have furnished of the corruption and larceny of the FY2026-27 state budget and the collusion therein of Westchester’s state legislators, first and foremost, Temporary Senate President Stewart Cousins and Assembly Ways and Means Committee Chair Pretlow, and, if not, the reason – and that this has been communicated to, and endorsed by, USA Today’s highest management, editors, and counsel, whose names and e-mail addresses I request.

Above-attached is CJA's NOTICE & grand jury/public corruption complaint pertaining to "Your April 1, 2026 2% D.A. salary increases, the 'false instrument' December 4, 2023 Report on which they are based, and other grand larcenies of the public fisc and violations of penal laws by NYS' highest public officers for inquiry by grand juries pursuant to Article I, §6 of the NYS Constitution – and, specifically, pertaining to the FY2026-27 state budget".

As stated,

"I am ready, immediately, to appear, under oath, before grand juries, so that they can discharge their constitutional function pursuant to [Article I, Section 6 of the New York State Constitution](#)^{fn7} and their statutory duties pursuant to [Criminal Procedure Law Article 190](#), including [§190.85](#) for a "grand jury report",^{fn8} Please advise as to the arrangements you will be making to enable me to do so, consistent with your own constitutional and statutory duties pursuant to [Article XIII, §§1, 13\(b\) of the State Constitution](#) and [County Law §700.1](#): "...it shall be the duty of every district attorney to conduct all prosecutions for crimes and offenses cognizable by the courts of the county for which he or she shall have been elected or appointed...".

TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE, both with respect to the FY2026-27 state budget and this year's elections for governor, attorney general, comptroller, all 213 legislative seats, judges – and for D.A.s. in at least seven counties.^{fn9} (bold in the original, pp. 4-5)
