Dear Gordon,

Greatly appreciate your returning my April  $29^{th}$  voice mail message. Here's the e-mail, with attachments, sent to Nick on April  $2^{nd}$  &  $3^{rd}$  – and reflecting the conversation I had with him on April  $1^{st}$ .

I got no response from Nick to this e-mail, other than an April 3<sup>rd</sup> e-mail acknowledgment that he'd "take a look". The voice mail I left for you on April 29<sup>th</sup> was when I was unable to find Nick's direct number. Upon finding it yesterday, I was able to reach him— and our conversation is reflected in the e-mail I thereupon sent him, with a copy to Executive Director Buzenberg, for whom I left a voice mail message immediately upon speaking with Nick. I will forward my yesterday's e-mail to you next.

There is NO WAY that real good-government, public-integrity reform can be achieved in NYS without journalists writing about the pervasive corruption that infests our state (& local) governments – all branches and at all levels.

Please find us <u>ONE</u> civic-minded, muckraking journalist – and let it be the start of a roster of such journalists that the Center for Public Integrity & its State Integrity Investigation Project can furnish good-government activists with corruption stories needing writers. The Center for Public Integrity would be performing a great public service by such roster – and by setting up a website bulletin board for activists and writers, or sending out regular e-mail blasts about opportunities for writers looking for corruption stories and about activists looking for writers. Surely, your funders – including the Omidyar Network & the Rita Allen Foundation who generously provided \$1,500,000 for the State Accountability Project – could be counted on to provide the relatively little money that would be required for this, especially when its results could be SO BIG.

I will call you next week – maybe, on my birthday, May 8<sup>th</sup> – when hopefully you'll be able to give me some good news.
