The enclosed sampling focuses on our ground-breaking litigation against New York's Commission on Judicial Conduct--which is supposed to--but does not--police the judiciary of this State and which defends itself by rank litigation misconduct when challenged:

(A) our August 14, 1995 Letter to the Editor, "Commission Abandons Investigative Mandate", published in the New York Law Journal, about our legal challenge to the New York State Commission on Judicial Conduct, which was dumped by the New York State Supreme Court;

(B) our April 14, 1995 Notice of Right to Seek Intervention, Notice of Petition, and Article 78 Petition against the New York State Commission on Judicial Conduct;

(C) our September 14, 1995 ethics complaint to the New York State Ethics Commission against the New York State Commission on Judicial Conduct and its attorney, the New York State Attorney General, for their litigation misconduct;

(D) our September 14, 1995 letter to the Chairman of the Commission on Judicial Conduct, enclosing our ethics complaint and calling upon the Commission to take corrective steps;

(E) our September 19, 1995 letter to Attorney General Dennis Vacco, enclosing our ethics complaint and calling upon him to take corrective steps.


