As also discussed with you, as well as previously with Warren, please include a sentence in the article--in addition to "we can't both be right..." that, at every turn, we have eagerly offered the underlying disciplinary files so that the truth can be established and the guilty parties brought to justice.

As set forth in my mother's February 6, 1994 letter to Attorney General, those files provide "prima facie, if not conclusive, evidence" of criminal conduct by the Appellate Division, Second Department and its at-will appointee, Gary Casella.

(note: I am enclosing the last pages of my April 5th and September 22nd correspondence with Warren as illustrative of our repeated proffer of "all the evidentiary documentation that we have readily available to us in our files".)
